Master of Science in Curriculum and Instruction

The Curriculum and Instruction degree is a comprehensive program that works to strengthen your instructional skills and leadership abilities.

The program consists of 12 required courses (36 credit hours), allowing you to complete the program in as little as 18 months. Sessions conveniently begin every eight weeks. You may even be able to transfer up to six credit hours from other regionally accredited universities.

Upon successful completion of this program, you will have gained new knowledge and broadened perspectives about contemporary instructional methods and strategies; increased your ability to interpret student, building and district test results and data; integrated curriculum across multiple disciplines; and enhanced your work on curriculum mapping, scope and sequences. You will be better prepared to move into a leadership position as a department chair, instructional specialist, director of curriculum, curriculum designer and other leadership positions of your choosing.

Master of Science in Educational Administration

The Educational Administration degree is a comprehensive program that provides you with the knowledge you need to become an exceptional leader in your organization.

The program consists of 13 required courses (39 credit hours), allowing you to complete the program in as little as 18 months. Sessions conveniently begin every eight weeks. You may even be able to transfer up to nine credit hours from other regionally accredited universities.

Upon successful completion of this program, you will have gained practical administrative knowledge and developed a more comprehensive understanding of school administration. You will be exposed to school finance, school law, personnel issues, complex organizations, and how to bring about change. Your degree will provide you an opportunity to apply for various administrative positions at the building or district levels.
